

Home Solar Maintenance Checklist

NEVER DO

- Use tap water (leaves mineral deposits)
- Use harsh chemicals or detergents
- Use abrasive sponges or rough brushes
- Walk or stand on panels
- Clean during hot weather
- Use pressure washers or high-pressure water

SAFETY CHECKS

- System powered OFF before starting
- Check for damaged wiring/cables
- Use professionals for high/difficult access
- Ensure stable, secure footing
- Clean during cool weather/early morning

EQUIPMENT READY

- Clean/purified water
- Biodegradable soap only
- Soft-bristle brush (long-handled)
- Microfiber cloths
- Squeegee with rubber blade

CLEANING STEPS

- Rinse panels with clean water
- Apply biodegradable soap
- Scrub gently in circular motions
- Rinse thoroughly
- Squeegee dry (no water spots)

Remember: Clean panels = 15-25% more energy production!
